Observations - What does it say?

- 1. What are the facts of the passage (Who? What? Where? When?)?
- 2. Grammar and Syntax (Repetition? Unusual words? Key terms?)?

Interpretation - What does it mean?

- 1. In one sentence, what is the main point of the passage?
- 2. How would the original audience have been affected by what is communicated?
- 3. How does this passage reveal our need for a savior? God's disposition to provide a savior?
- 4. How does this passage connect to the overall storyline of the Bible? How does it point to Jesus as the Savior?

Application - What is the significance for us?

- 1. How does God want this passage to function in my life? In our church?
- 2. What kind of a response does this passage call for from us? Are there:
 - Examples to follow?
 - Commandments to obey?
 - Sins to forsake?
 - Promises to claim?
 - Principles to live by?
 - Invitations to worship?
- 3. Motivated by grace, how does God want me to be different in light of this passage?
