Identity: Servants

1. Introduction

- a. What did we learn last week about our identity in Christ as family?
- b. What specific ideas did you come up with to live in light of that identity?
Have you seen God growing you in this way this week? Do you see ways you can grow more?
- c. How does the fact that we are family together lead us to praise?

2. This week: Servants

- a. Read Scriptures (Matt. 20:25-28; John 13:1-20; Philippians 2:5-11; 1 Peter 2:15-17).
- b. Where in the story do we see this idea of God's people being servants?
 - i. How does the gospel make us servants?
- c. What other Scriptures can you think of that reinforce the idea that we are servants as God's people? (Write them below the Scriptures on the worksheet.)
- d. What are the implications for us? What should our life together look like in light of the fact that we are servants in Christ? (Brainstorm. Write most important ideas on the worksheet at the bottom.)
- e. Why do you think this idea of being servants is so important for the church?
- f. Why do you think being servants is important for those outside the church?
- g. Where have you seen God's at work among us in this aspect of our identity? Where have you seen yourself, others grow in this way? (Be specific!)
- h. How can we grow more? What practical ways do you think we could grow together in this way?

3. Pray that God would do this work among us.

- a. All our growth in godliness is according to the Father's plan to renew us in

Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

- b. Ask that God would show us more grace according to his will for us to serve one another and those outside the church.
