

Discipleship Training Three Identity: Learners/Disciples

1. Introduction

- a. What did we learn last week about our identity in Christ as servants?
- b. What specific ideas did you come up with to live in light of that identity?
Have you seen God growing you in this way this week? Do you see ways you can grow more?

2. This week: Servants

- a. Read Scriptures (Deut. 6:4-9; John 8:31-32; 2 Tim. 3:16; Col. 2:1-4; John 15:7-17).
- b. Where in the story do we see this idea of God's people being learners/disciples?
- c. What other Scriptures can you think of that reinforce this identity? (Write them below the Scriptures on the worksheet.)
- d. What are the implications for us? What should our spiritual lives look like in light of this identity? (Brainstorm. Write most important ideas on the worksheet at the bottom.)
- e. As disciples, is our study meant to simply grow us in knowledge? Why/not?
- f. How should increased knowledge lead to increased obedience in our lives?

3. Prayer

- a. How can we grow more? What practical ways do you think we could grow together in this way? Pray that God would do this work among us.
- b. All our growth in godliness is according to the Father's plan to renew us in Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- c. Ask that God would show us more grace according to his will for us to serve one another and those outside the church.
