

## **Discipleship Training Four**

### **Identity: Sent (Mission)**

#### 1. Introduction

- a. What did we learn last week about our identity in Christ as learners?
- b. What specific ideas did you come up with to live in light of that identity?
- c. Have you seen God growing you in this way this week? Do you see ways you can grow more?

#### 2. This week: Sent

- a. Read Scriptures (John 20:19-23; Matt. 28:16-20; Acts 2:42-47; 4:23-37; 8:1-8; 13:1-3).
- b. Where in the story do we see this idea of God's people being sent on mission?
- c. What other Scriptures can you think of that reinforce this aspect of our identity in Christ? (Write them below the Scriptures on the worksheet.)
- d. What are the implications for us? How should this change how we live? (Brainstorm. Write most important ideas on the worksheet at the bottom.)
- e. Where have you seen God's at work among us in this aspect of our identity? Where have you seen yourself, others grow in this way? (Be specific!)
- f. God has called us to be missionaries where we live. How can we reach our neighborhoods for the gospel? How can we communicate the gospel to our culture?
- g. What are some practical ways we can intentionally love our neighbors, build relationships with non-believers, and gain opportunities for the gospel?

#### 3. Pray that God would work among us

- a. How can we grow more? What practical ways do you think we could grow together in this way? Pray that God would do this work among us.
- b. All our growth in godliness is according to the Father's plan to renew us in Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

- c. Ask that God would show us more grace according to his will for us to serve one another and those outside the church.
